## **Tech Corner**



**Summer storage tip.** As most everyone is aware by now, the new E10 fuel can cause major havoc with all of our motorized toys. This is my theory. Additives may work, but I think the less fuel that is there to turn bad, the less of an issue it will be when I add a full tank of fresh gas at the beginning of next season.

**Carbureted models** with fuel shut-off valve – Add correct amount of additive (of your choice) to your tank. Start the engine and then turn off the fuel. Let it idle until it shuts down. (Making sure not to overheat engine) Siphon as much fuel out of the tank as possible and use it in your lawn mower or even vehicle)

**Fuel injected models** or with out a fuel shut-off valve. Add additive, run engine for a while making sure not to overheat and shut down manually, siphon and re-use in another vehicle. Before you start your sled again next season add at least 5 Gallons of premium fuel. I have used this method the past couple of years with no issues.
