Snowmobile Storage <u>Tips</u>

- 1.) Make sure to store your snowmobile in a clean, cool, dry place that is protected from weather and sunlight.
- 2.) Clean and wax the exterior of your vehicle as if it were going into a show. This will protect it from dust and scratches and make it look nice to boot!
- If your snowmobile is in need of service, take care of it before you put your snowmobile into storage.
- 4.) Before you store the snowmobile, wash it thoroughly to get off all of the corrosive acids, dirt's and salts that may be on it. It is also highly recommended that you drain any remaining gasoline out of your snowmobile.
- 5.) Spray all of the metal parts of your snowmobile with special storing oil, as this will help preserve these parts.
- 6.) It is also a good idea to take snowmobile's track off of the floor and put the skis on top of an elevated board. This will help prevent rotting.
- 7.) Plug the air box inlet and exhaust outlet to ensure no mice or other rodents get in during storage.
- 8.) Drain the chain-case and refill with the documented fluid.
- 9.) Remove the drive belt, spray a dry lubricant on all track clips and wipe the seat with a lubricant
- 10.) Never keep your engine running in an enclosed area.
